

# What Resources Do You Need to Adapt to Climate Change?

Researchers at the University of Vermont have a new USDA funded grant focused on assisting producers to adapt to climate change, and developing resources for climate adaptation in collaboration with farmers. The project is targeting small, medium and beginning farmers and ranchers. The first step of this project is to interview farmers about their climate change perceptions and potential adaptation needs.
